Educational resources for domestic violence awareness and action

November is National Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Canada. This commemorative month aims to promote education and prevention, support survivors, and advocate for policies to combat domestic violence.

Domestic violence occurs within various types of relationships, including intimate partners, married, unmarried, and common-law couples, and among family members. Statistically, certain groups tend to be more commonly affected or more vulnerable, including women, children, 2SLGBTQI+ individuals, and people with disabilities. However, people of any gender can be both victims and perpetrators of violence, and domestic violence can affect anyone, regardless of age, gender, race, sexual orientation, socioeconomic status, or background.


Domestic violence can significantly impact the workplace, and employers are crucial in addressing this issue and supporting affected employees. Employers can support employees facing domestic violence by creating a safe environment, providing resources and education, and implementing policies that protect employees. Not only does this benefit the individuals involved, but it also contributes to a safer and more compassionate workplace overall.
