Educational resources on Islamophobia

According to the Council of American-Islamic Relations (CAIR), Islamophobia is a close-minded and religious-based hatred, fear, or prejudice toward Islam and Muslims which results in discrimination, marginalization, or oppression. In [Canada's Anti-Racism Strategy](#), Islamophobia includes racism, stereotypes, fear, and/or acts of hostility directed towards Muslims. In addition, Islamophobia can unfairly lead to viewing and treating Muslims as a greater security threat on an institutional, systemic, and societal level.

One commonly seen form of Islamophobia is the depiction of Muslim stereotypes in the media. The [Riz Test](#) was named after actor/musician Riz Ahmed after he had spoken to the House of Commons in 2017 about Muslim representation in popular media. It lists criteria and raises questions about Muslim stereotypes, for example, how are they portrayed? Are they angry? Are they depicted as part of a terrorist organization? We invite you to utilize the Riz Test to evaluate some of the media provided in this guide, or any other media you encounter that includes Muslim characters and Islamic themes.

This guide provides resources to combat Islamophobia and showcase support and respect to Muslims living in Canada and in North America, as well as celebrating this belief and religion.


